To Whom it May Concern,

The IMDS is a database developed by the Automotive Industry to track the substances suppliers use to manufacture automobile parts. Certain substances are considered hazardous per international regulations and should be recorded in this system.

Currently, AM/NS Calvert (IMDS co. ID 229059) has three (4) IMDS records. These records include a chemistry that is a derivation of the widest tolerances for the ingredients in the steel making recipes. The actual chemistries of the steel are recorded on the test certificates or bills of lading for material shipped to the client.
